Continuing our discipleship in "Walking the Way, living the life of Jesus" in our local churches and Synod/United Areas, etc., the time has come for us to come together again to discern God's plan for Southern Synod. So, I look forward, with eagerness, to welcoming you to our Synod Together meeting as stated above.

The theme for this autumn's meeting is **"Walking the Way: Living the life of Jesus" - Discerning God's plan for Southern Synod**. We are very grateful to the Revd Kevin Watson, Moderator of the General Assembly of the United Reformed Church 2016-2018 for accepting our invitation as our Guest Speaker. He will address us in the morning and afternoon sessions. After lunch, the young people will go ten pin bowling. This is a free event, but those attending will need to bring their own packed lunch and cover the cost of transport to and from Goring URC.
