SYNOD CYDO:

Tom is continuing to work through the renewal of Child Friendly Church Awards and any new applications as well as continued Safeguarding training.

Tom has advertised running further CORE skills sessions, however, there has been no uptake on these but several churches have said that they have done something similar and so they want something else. Possibly publicising what these "CORE" skills are could increase the uptake.

The committee have looked at other possible training subjects including:

- storytelling such as Godly Play
- Messy Church training
- mental health training (Wessex currently have run one)- Young minds.

Along with General Assembly, Tom has also visited a Holiday Club in Cheam, some Messy Churches, and meetings about the potential of employing Youth Workers etc.

There is a music event called SING being run which will run alongside the November Youth Executive on 23-25 November with plans to then play at Youth Assembly.
