NOTE: As with any Family talk, you need to made it relevant to the Church where it is being used, and also use the material according to your presentation style. On the powerpoint you will find images which may well be suitable, but amend it using images relating to the context you are speaking in. e.g. when a church building is referred to, use a picture of the actual building you are speaking in. Similarly when talking about people who are the real church, if possible use images of folk from the church you are in. Each * shows when in the talk the powerpoint should be moved on. If you don't have access to Powerpoint, the crossword can easily be recreated on a flip chart.

Encourage the younger folk to answer first, before the adults chip in!

START QUESTION: What do you think of when you hear the word Church?

Do these look like a church? * (show photos of church buildings)

PROBLEM: Jesus said: I will build my church...
Is this what he had in mind... building something like this?

Can you imagine Jesus laying a concrete foundation... *

Then cementing bricks on it *

Putting in windows / doors etc *

JESUS had something very different in mind... not a building at all.

He had in mind a group of people

When Jesus talks about Church: he means a group of people *
But not just any group of people.

LET'S PLAY A GAME to discover who they are.

NOTE: Explain that each answer to the first set of clues should fit in a sentence along the lines of: "The church is made up of people who *******

Jesus"

After each answer, give a brief explanation of the implications. e.g After 1 down: explain that the Church is made up of people who choose to follow Jesus. Ensure everyone knows what that means.

* CROSSWORD ANSWER

1 Down: To go after Follow *

8 Across: Celebrated on Valentines day Love *

9 Down: Do what you are told Obey *

3 Across: Express love and devotion Worship *

COMMENT: God wants *everyone* to be part of His Church but He leaves us to choose whether or not we want to.

Not just when we meet together as a group


Not just in a building
