## **Brockley and New Cross CRCW Project**

As a Church Related Community Worker (CRCW), or Community Minister, I am working with two churches, St. Andrew's, Brockley, and St. Michael's United Church, New Cross.

The Ministry, through Community Development principles, is to build partnerships, build sustainability, and respond to the huge issues that affect our communities... to enable the Church to be relevant to its community. Currently, by far the biggest challenge facing our communities is poverty, and the cost-of-living crisis.

The first year has been about getting to know people, building bridges, forging those partnerships in community, and building trust. Partnerships are being built with the credit union, foodbank, debt advice services and refugee services. As part of this, I would like to highlight the Monthly Christian Prayer Vigil at the Home Office (third Monday of the month from 12.30pm – 1.30pm), where an ecumenical group hold a service to remember those who were victims of global migration (222 who died in March 2022 were remembered). A very poignant and dignified response to current Government rhetoric and policy.

Your prayers, please, as we continue to explore with St. Michael's United Church (Local Ecumenical Project with the Anglicans), their vision for mission with the congregation, the building and community engagement.
