

SIDCUP, BEXLEY & GEDDES PLACE

Bexley Pastorate URC is constituted by three churches: Geddes Place URC in Bexleyheath, Bexley URC in Bexley village and Emmanuel United, an LEP, URC and Methodist church in Sidcup. The three churches share a full-time minister and some activities. A team of preachers helps to lead services each Sunday. The strength of the three churches is their fellowship groups, which bring together people from the neighbourhood for lunches, cafés and entertainment. Ecumenical relations are also strong in the borough, through regular meetings and joint activities throughout the Christian year. As with many URC congregations, the main difficulty in Bexley is the ageing of the members, with the feeling that as society changes, people and families are less likely to join a congregation and even less likely to volunteer for church, community or charity work. Bexley's elders and minister are praying for inspiration to find new ways of sharing the Good News in this context, responding to new needs in society and serving the people in our communities.
