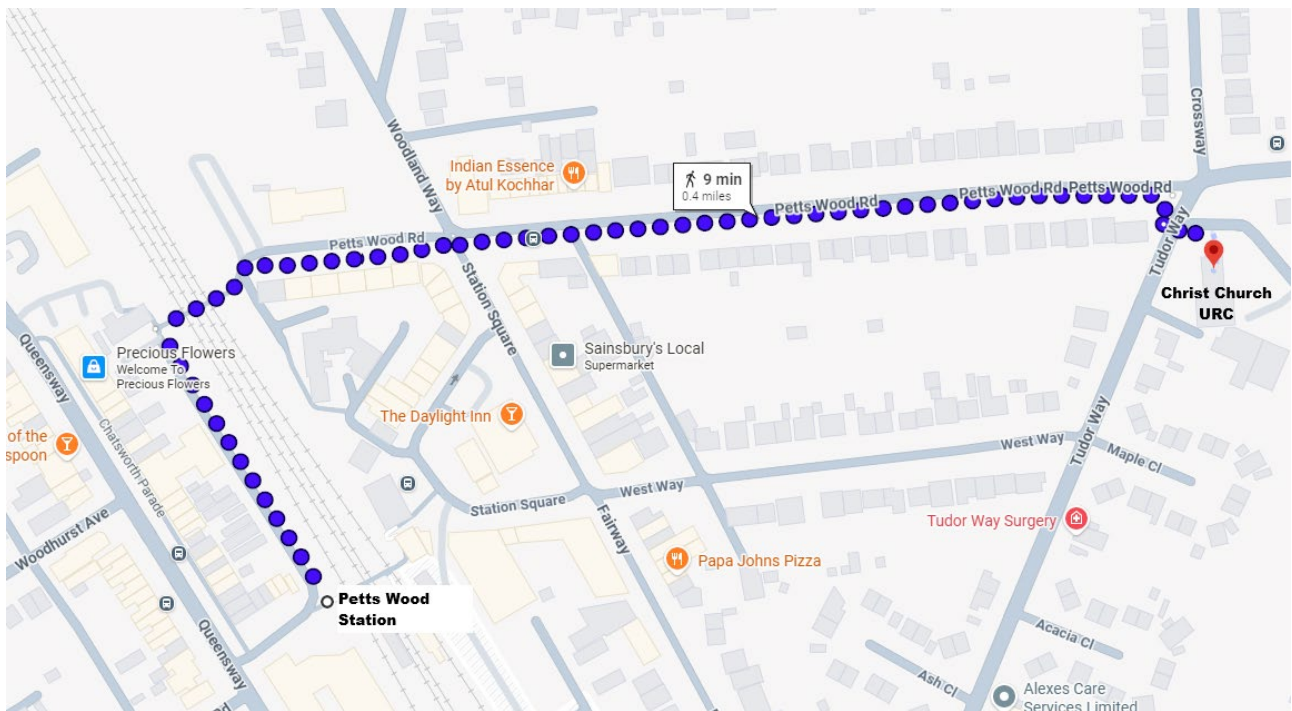


Travelling to Christ Church

By Train

Petts Wood train station is a 10 minute walk (0.4 miles) from Christ Church. There are currently extensive works to the bridge happening at present. This means that no access from the platforms to the station square side of Petts Wood (the side nearest the church). Instead, leave via the Queensway side of Petts Wood station, turn right up Queensway, cross over to the East side of Petts Wood using the green footbridge and walk down Petts Wood Road to the Church. By Car

Christ Church URC is in the Ultra Low Emission Zone.

Car parking at the church

There are two car parks at the church.

The Tudor Way car park will have reserved parking for people who have requested this in advance. If you require a disabled space here please contact Lauren modpa@urcsouthern.org.uk

The Willett Way car park will be first come first served. Please park round the edge of the car park so that we can maximise spaces.

Car Parks within 10 minutes walk of BR5 1LH:

Queensway Car Park Petts Wood, BR5 1BX, from 90p per hour.

Memorial Hall Car Park Petts Wood, BR5 1LG, from 90p per hour.

There is also a fair amount of On-Street paid parking (via Ringo) within Petts Wood but these spaces are at more of a premium.

Free street parking within a 5-10 minute walk of the church:

Nearer the top of Willett Way the road is wider and there are fewer or no parking restrictions. Do not park on the single yellow lines nearer the church on Willett Way.

There are also other roads off Willett Way which if cars park on just one side of the road provide free and safe parking. For example Priory Avenue, St Georges Road, Greencourt Road.

Tudor Way – The single yellow line can be parked on during a Saturday but please note this is a busy road.
